

As of today, we are officially halfway through the first month of 2022! How are you doing on your New Year's Resolutions?

Maybe you are not one of the 39% of Americans who made a resolution this year, but perhaps you did, and according to Statista's Global Community Survey, chances are it was either to Exercise More, Eat Healthier, or Lose Weight. Another survey showed that by this point in January, 64% of those people are well on their way to abandoning their goal (much to the relief of regular gym members who suddenly find their favorite treadmill open again).

While reading the Bible wasn't listed on that national survey, from experience, I know that is one goal that Christians often make at the beginning of the year. In fact, if you do a Google search for "Read the Bible in a Year" you can get more than 754,000,000 results. This is a very worthy goal for a follower of Christ, yet many of us get behind in our reading, which causes us to become overwhelmed and disappointed, and then we give up. I am no exception to this, which is why I recommend ditching the Bible reading plan in favor of a Bible reading checklist.

A Bible reading checklist is a simple visual method to help you keep track of all the Bible reading you do, whether it be in Bible class, during worship service, while reading with your kids, or during your morning quiet time. There are no dates assigned, no prescribed reading order, and no minimum amount to be read daily; but every time a box is checked off, it gives you a little sense of accomplishment and encourages you to keep going. This method has helped me in my desire to become more consistent in my scripture reading more than any other goal or plan. The first time I read completely through the Bible, it took me three years, and rather than feeling disappointed in the amount of time that it took, I felt proud of my accomplishment!
