Brother Frank preached on doing the impossible last week. He used the term BHAG (Big Hairy Audacious Goal). He gave examples of seemingly impossible tasks that were met by groups of people who began to think the impossible was not impossible. Brother Gregg Strawn redefined the term BHAG to mean by the Hand of Almighty God. The writer of Hebrews tells us there is something that is impossible for us to do. He tells us “...it is impossible to please Him...” (Heb 11:6). That is what the accuser would like us to believe. But anything can be taken out of context. Let’s read this in context.

Hebrews 11:6
6 And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Brother Frank admitted that even in the world that does not subscribe to the existence of God, faith is an essential part of achieving large goals. It is also a component of discovery God requires of us if we are to even know him. It is more than just recognizing his existence, but it acknowledges his nature and involvement in our lives. The last part reads "... He is a rewarder of those who seek him." Faith is required to do the impossible but as Jesus says, "with God all things are possible." (Matt. 19:26)

Are we ready to move mountains? Are we ready to know God fully? Are we ready to achieve Big Hairy Audacious Goals? I hope so, but it will be only By the Hand of Almighty God. So, has your faith grown enough to trust God with the impossible? If so, let's trust God together and identify our BHAG.
