Home.

Let do you think of when you hear the word "home"?

For me it can be a smell, a sound, the flavor or even a déjà vu moment.

A distant lawnmower, a small, propped airplane flying overhead on an unrequited afternoon, the smell of a freshly cut lawn, a bean and cheese burrito. Many things cause me to think of home.

But I can return home having been gone for 30 years and, although some things are the same, many things are different. Even home doesn't feel like home anymore.

My grandparents have passed on. Many of my cousins have moved away. Relationships have disintegrated. Big businesses have moved in and taken up farmland. Buildings that I frequented have been torn down. Even home doesn't feel like home anymore.

We sing, "This world is not my home. I'm just a passing through." We are strangers in a strange land. What was familiar does not stay familiar. But recognizing this Jesus leaves us with these words:

> "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. 2 My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am..." (John 14:1-3)

He is gone to prepare for us the dwelling place. A place where he will dwell with his people. A place we can call home. I miss home. Home is more than buildings and farmland and freshly cut grass. Home is where family dwells. Where relationships are healthy and whole. Jesus goes to prepare this place for us. Do you miss home? Remember the words of Jesus Christ, "Do not let your hearts be troubled..." I go to prepare home for you.
