

From The Desk Of Reneé Gunselman & Geri York

Pride Goes Before A Fall
During the last year I (Geri) have prayed
through my blindness. As I prayed, many scriptures
came to mind. One of them is 1 Cor. 10:13: "God is
faithful and will not let you be tempted beyond your
ability and will also plan a way of escape so that you
may endure it".

I want to start by saying life is an adventure. A year ago January, I lost my sight from a bacterial infection. I came home from the hospital and fell and broke my left arm. Through these two experiences, I started thinking more about my life and the many ways I have been prideful. I've had experiences that caused me to be prideful. I was the president of Medford Teachers Association and received much recognition from that. While living in assisted living, I was asked to be an ambassador for new residents that came. As a result, I knew the name of every person that lives in Stoneybrook Lodge. Again, I received a lot of recognition for that. Even during the times when I was a game player, I won a lot of games and I became prideful of that as well. I began playing the piano at age 7 and it led to a tuition scholarship at Abilene Christian University, which also led me to more pride in my life. Now, I can't play the piano because of my arthritis.

Instead of focusing on not being able to see or not being able to play the piano, I want to focus on what I can learn from my life adventures and what God has taught me. one of the hardest things about my blindness is that I can't read my Bible for myself. I've learned that I have a lot of pride in my life and have been focused on all the things I'm good at instead of focusing on the things God is so good at like his providence or care and provisions for me and my church family. God sometimes brings us down in order to build us up, to make us humble. I have learned perspective through my blindness and through my broken arm. I am thankful that the next thing I am going to see is in Heaven, the face of my Lord Jesus Christ. I leave with you this scripture to ponder when challenges in your life seem unbearable or when your pride gets in the way. Joshua 1:9: "Be strong and courageous do not be afraid and do not be dismayed for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go".
