

Hello Church Family!

Following up on Frank Cloutier’s announcement last week, I wanted to share some exciting news—Elders Rolland and Ed have asked a small group of us to kick off our search for a new pulpit minister!

The elders reached out to Frank, Lydia Perry, Thomas Wood, Bill McCaughan, and myself to act as a small cross-section of the church and get things off the ground in our efforts to find a new minister. Gregg Strawn is also serving as a consultant to the group. So far, we have developed a job description and qualifications based on the material and process used by the last minister search committee, posted that information on a section of the church website, and started to get the word out to several Christian universities and preacher organizations. The universities we have reached out to are: Abilene Christian University, Harding University (including the graduate school), Pepperdine University, David Lipscomb University, and Oklahoma Christian University. We have received a few initial inquiries, and we expect more as the postings go live across these platforms.

We are looking forward to getting you involved in this process as well! We need you to be **praying** for God to guide this process and to bring the right folks to us in His time. We request that you **spread the word** to people you know in the broader church, including ministers who may know other ministers looking for a position (or perhaps be interested themselves). As we get farther in the process, we look forward to inviting you to get involved in the interview process and in sharing your impressions of candidates.

It is difficult to say what the timing will be for God to bring a new minister to Circle, and there are several other congregations in the Pacific Northwest also recruiting. However, we are hoping to have candidates to bring before you this fall, and we are praying for us to be patient with God’s timing as He grows and prepares us in the meantime.

What is happening in the meantime? This has been an excellent opportunity for men—including young men—in our congregation to develop their skills speaking to the church, and for us to hear messages from retired minister Gregg. It has been a great opportunity to hear from the elders and other preachers in the area and learn from them. We want to give a big THANK YOU to Eric Bracht for his efforts to recruit and coordinate speakers, and we look forward to more lessons from folks we would not necessarily get to hear from otherwise.

May God continue to bless our congregation and bless the men and families who will consider working with us here at Circle.
