Why does it matter for Christians to “get along”?

This is a huge question that will have many aspects to a full and complete answer. Much more than can be discussed fully in a small article like this. I do want to touch on some thoughts here, though, as food for thought in your daily Bible study and prayer. For each of these scriptures read more than just a single verse so you can get the context and overall focus of the message.

Genesis 1:27 God created mankind in His own image. He created every single one of us so every single one of us is special to Him beyond that of the rest of creation.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. God loves us so much that He gave His only Son to suffer and die in order to bring us back in relationship with Him.

I Peter 4:8 Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.

John 15:12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you.

I Corinthians 12:12 Just as a body, though one, has many parts

Over and over in the scriptures I am told that we are All valuable to God. It seems that if I am remaining humble myself and placing greater value on God’s opinions and lordship of my life then I will become less focused on my “rights” and more focused on pleasing God. I just finished up a great week counseling at Camp Yamhill High School Camp. Two young ladies gave their lives to Jesus and we had more than 16 sign up for recruit's weekend! If you have kids grades 1-12, I strongly suggest sending them to this wonderful Bible camp. You can check the dates here: campyamhill.org. Also, Round Lake Christian Camp is a more affordable option for grades 6-12, and occurs July 31-August 6 (roundlakechristiancamp.org). If you have kids/teens, please send them to AT LEAST one week of summer camp. Don't let sports get in the way--your teens can take a week off. Summer camp is the most likely place for your child to 1) commit their life to Jesus and 2) meet a Christian spouse. My sister did both of these things at Camp Yamhill! Bible Camp is more important than your child learning one week's worth of football plays that they will never use after high school. Also, don't let cost be an issue. Round Lake is only \$130, or your student can be a counselor and experience Bible Camp for free. Also, whatever your age, consider taking a week as a counselor yourself. Every camp I've ever worked at is always short staffed and even one extra pair of responsible eyes goes a long way. I've always been impressed by Eryn and Jasmine Womack, who take a week every year to counsel Khalil at Roundlake. It's good for Jesus and for their family.

Finally, Bible Camp is a lot of fun. Jesus uses noodle fights and slip and slides to bring young people to him. It's not a stoic sacrifice, it's a blast.
