From The Desk Of Mark Johnson

Justice is a concept that our culture is paying attention to. There’s justice for the unborn. Justice for the disenfranchised. Environmental justice. Last week in the Sunday Morning Adult Class we had an in-depth study and discussion on Justice; God’s Justice. Justice can be defined as the principle that people get what they deserve. Another related word that has bearing on this is the word Just. This is based on behaving according to what is morally right and fair. Our God is just, but at the same time He demands justice. We like justice when laws are broken, and consequences are meted out to the law breakers. However, when we’re the law breakers we desire mercy! Don’t you agree? Romans 3:23 reminds us of this.

Romans 3:23 “For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.”

While our God is just and demands justice, He knew that we could not perfectly keep the Law because we’re weak, sinful people living in a fallen world. We’re hopelessly lost in our sin! The amazing thing is that God provided the perfect remedy for our situation, that being the blood of Jesus Christ, the perfect sacrifice that covers our past, present, and future sins! Praise God that even though we are sinners and deserve the consequences of our sin (justice) He shows us mercy so that when we are in Christ, Christ’s blood covers our sin! We are restored and redeemed because of what God accomplished through Jesus.

At 3:16 every afternoon Nancy’s phone alarm goes off. It’s to remind her of John 3:16 and she often says it out loud. I like to include John 3:17 too.

John 3:16 – 17: 16For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. 17For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

As Gregg Strawn said last Sunday “God demands justice, and He provides the solution.” Jesus Christ is the solution that keeps us from getting what we deserve. We should not feel entitled because we’re believers and forgiven, rather we should feel humbled by the great love that God has for us that He provided solution for our sin! God be praised!
