# From The Desk Of Maria Zhang

"I thank God whom I serve, as did my ancestors, with a clear conscience, as I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day. As I remember your tears, I long to see you, that I may be filled with joy. I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well. For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands..."

~2 Timothy 1:3-7

There is so much to unpack in just these few lines that Paul opened his first letter to Timothy with. The first thing that jumps out at me is that Paul opens his letter with the conviction that he is serving the same God his ancestors served, and that both he and his ancestors serve God with a clear conscience, despite the fact that Paul is a Christian and his ancestors were Jews. I am sure that the way they serve God looks different, and we know they follow different traditions, but they all serve the same God with clear consciences.

The next thing I noticed was that Paul longed to see Timothy so that he (Paul) could be filled with joy. Do you have a friend who brings you such joy when you see them? What can we do to inspire joy in others when we see them?

The final thing that stood out to me was that Timothy's grandmother and mother played a huge part in imparting faith in him. As a soon-to-be mother myself, I definitely look up to these women and am inspired to follow their example.

I can't wait to hear even more insights from this passage from Howard Jones this morning!
