From The Desk Of Jennifer House Pride

We have all struggled with pride in our lives at one point or another. It can take the form of stubbornness, and refusal to listen or accept advice:

“Where there is strife, there is pride, but wisdom is found in those who take advice.”Proverbs 13:10

Pride can cause us to avoid certain people:

“Each one should test their own actions. Then they can take pride in themselves alone, without comparing themselves to someone else...” Galatians 6:4

Pride can even cause us to dismiss a valid interpretation of scripture because that might mean that we have been looking at it from a faulty perspective for years:

“Do you see a person wise in their own eyes? There is more hope for a fool than for them.” Proverbs 26:12

Regardless of how pride manifests in our lives, it’s apparent that God despises it, and wants us to seek humility instead. This is true for the “least” of us as well as for the “greatest”. We see countless examples in the world around us of leaders who have become prideful, and we have only to turn to the scriptures to understand that this never turns out well. For example, King Uzziah in 2 Chronicles chapter 26 started his reign off so strongly. He focused on God and was blessed because of it. He even invented great "engines of war". However:

“But when he became strong, his heart was so proud that he acted corruptly, and he was unfaithful to the Lord his God...”

Like Uzziah, isn't it true that when things are going well for us, we tend to get cocky and forget to give credit where credit is due? But, when things go wrong, it’s so easy to blame others. This week, I challenge us all to ask God to help us be humble instead of prideful. I pray that He will help us identify areas in our lives where we are allowing pride to direct our thoughts and actions. And, I challenge us to praise God through the bad as well as the good and to remember that NO circumstance or accomplishment is blessed without Him.
