## From The Desk Of Misty Freeman

Spiritual Fruit: Proof We're Getting Good at This

How do you know if you are getting good at something? First, it is important to learn what it looks like to be good at that thing. For instance, being good at soccer looks like scoring goals and keeping the other team from doing the same. Being a good student looks like showing up to class, reading the material, and acing exams. Being a good employee means performing the duties of your position in a timely way and with a good attitude.

How do we know if we are getting good at being like Jesus? We can learn about what it means to be like Jesus in the Bible. Spending time in the scriptures, especially reading about the life of Jesus as described in the gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John helps us understand what He was like, so that we can seek to mirror Him. The Apostle Paul sums up the traits of Jesus in Galatians 5:22-23. That passage reads:

> ...the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, selfcontrol...

Those words describe what it looks like when someone has mastered living like Jesus, one whose life shows spiritual fruit, developing from the inside out, and sharing with others the benefits.

However, it takes more than learning to reach the goal. It also takes practice. On day one, we can read all about the rules of soccer and how to win a game, but we are not automatically good at the running and shooting and defending. It takes lots of practice with drills and scrimmages and coaching. It takes setting aside time consistently to try and fail and try again until we get it right more times than not. What's more, the better the soccer player, the more they continue to practice and make soccer a main focus of their life.

Similarly, in seeking to be like Jesus, it takes lots of practice to get good. We get better by consistently trying to be like Jesus, trying and failing and trying again until we get it right more times than not. And the better we get, the more being like Jesus becomes the focus of our lives.
