From The Desk Of Misty Freeman

In the book of James 1:2-4 (NLT), it says, "Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing."

How can we find the good that God means for us and the people we care about, in the midst of physical and emotional pain? How can trust that God is with us, through it all?

It's not about pretending that nothing's wrong, that there's suddenly nothing to be upset about. We see examples of God's people throughout the Bible experiencing great sorrow, weeping, asking for God to take away their pain. Hannah, the mother of Samuel, wept and wept before the Lord (1 Samuel 1). The Apostle Paul says he begged God to take away his "thorn in the flesh," so difficult it was for him (2 Corinthians 12). Jesus Himself was "anguished and distressed," crying out to God to take away His "cup of suffering" (Matthew 26). These are understandable human reactions to the hard stuff in each of our lives.

What God offers is that He is here, and He provides beautiful things worth celebrating, even in the darkest seasons. What is up to us is what we're going to focus on...and therefore, what we will see. Philippians 4:6-9 reads, "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank Him for all He has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus...Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise...then the God of peace will be with you."

There is also so much comfort in knowing how big and powerful our God is. The whole chapter of Isaiah 41 emphasizes God's might, and in verse 10 God tells those who serve Him, "Do not be afraid, for I am with you. Do not be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand."

Take heart, my friends and family! Jesus tells His followers in John 16:33, "Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world."
