To wait...such a difficult thing to do and such a difficult circumstance in which to be. From our first breath, we find ourselves waiting - the newborn babe waits for her caregiver to meet her every need. As we grow and develop, we become less dependent and we no longer have to wait on others to fill our basic needs. However, even the most capable and selfsufficient will eventually and repeatedly find themselves in life's "waiting room" (a circumstance where waiting is required). Sometimes we're in the waiting room for a short stay, other times our waiting room visit extends so long it becomes our temporary home.

Webster-Merriam defines "wait" in this way:

- 1. to stay in place in expectation
- 2. to delay
- 3. to serve (food and drinks)
- 4. to pause (for another to catch up)


5. to remain temporarily neglected or unrealized Such a vast array of meanings for this four-letter word! The definitions are as varied as my unchecked response to waiting. I confess that in my waiting I often bounce from a stance of eager anticipation to impatience and manipulation, from meandering along the journey with occasional "reststops" to curling up into a ball of insecurity, self-pity, or bitterness! In my more rational moments, I know that God has not called me to journey with Him in that way.

It won't surprise you to know that the Bible has quite a bit to say about waiting. According to the International Standard Bible Encyclopedia, the most important and frequent use of the word "wait," is to define "the attitude of a soul Godward." What happens when I wait with a God-ward attitude of my soul? I have a:

- listening ear,
- heart responsive to the wooing of God,
- mind focused on heavenly (kingdom) things,
- peaceful patience, and
- confident expectation of God at work.

Doesn't that sound so much better than my unchecked response to waiting described above? So, when you find yourself in life's waiting room, turn toward your Heavenly Father and enjoy the journey with the blessings of waiting with a God-ward attitude of the soul.
