Community Outreach is important for churches, and it is something that Circle excels at. In fact, it is something we are known for. While working with International Student programs at other churches, we tell people we are from Circle Church of Christ, and the first thing people say is, "Isn't that the church that does the Clothing Give Away?". We proudly tell them "Yes!" We have three events coming up this summer that will serve our Corvallis community, and we would love to have you participate or volunteer to help!

We are hosting a blood drive, and we need donors! Have you seen headlines for the past few years about a blood shortage? According to Vitalant (a nonprofit organization that collects blood from donors), 38% of people in the US are eligible to donate blood, and 3% of eligible donors donate. If you are willing, please **sign up to donate blood** at redcrossblood.org/give.html. Type "97330" into the zip code search bar, find Circle's blood drive, and make an appointment. If you don't want to donate, you can **spread the word** about our blood drive, or **volunteer** to help here during the drive.

We are hosting a Lifeline screening event for people in the Corvallis community. People can choose to receive a carotid artery screening, peripheral arterial disease screening, abdominal aortic aneurism screening, atrial fibrillation screening, or all four. These screens help people assess their risk of a heart attack or stroke. Please help us **spread the word** about this upcoming screening, and talk to Maria if you would like to **volunteer** to help. If you are interested in any of the screenings, contact Maria. Discounts are available for church members.

Loralea Glenn is heading up our Clothing Ministry now, and there will be a Children's Give Away in August, with sizes fitting newborns through teenagers. Now is a great time to clean out your closets and donate children's clothes, linens, baby items, and any unused disposable diapers or clean cloth diapers.
