On Friday July 28th, Circle is holding a heart clinic. We are hosting a Lifeline screening event for people in the Corvallis community. People can choose to receive a carotid artery screening, peripheral arterial disease screening, abdominal aortic aneurism screening, atrial fibrillation screening, or all four. These screenings provide peace of mind or early detection.

These screens are important, and they could help save the lives of at risk people in our families, church, or community. Please help us spread the word about this upcoming screening, and talk to Maria if you would like to volunteer to help with the screening at the church.

If you are interested in any of the screenings, pick up one of the pink flyers in the foyer. Online registration for appointments is required, so if you want to make an appointment, please do so as soon as possible. You can choose which screenings you want, or you can receive all 4 screenings. Medicare is not accepted, insurance is not required, and a 50% discount is available for church members, making all 4 screenings \$149.

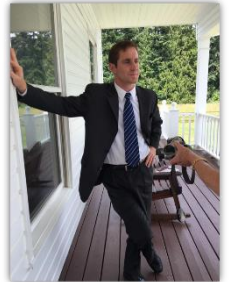

Camp Yamhill Report: Our Theme was "This is the Way," focusing on John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the father except through me." I had the honor of getting to preach on the theme verse. I shared some of my knowledge about other religions, and why they can't get you all the way to God—only Jesus is the way. This message hit the camp like an atom bomb. Kids were challenging me like crazy. This message does not mesh well with our post-modern, relativistic, anti-imperial society and it's certainly not what the teens are learning at school. However, one teen with Vietnamese parents came to me every meal time to ask questions, and we answered his questions with scripture. At the end of the week, he told me he was going to get Baptized when he got home (I didn't ask)! We had 8 baptisms at camp, and I just saw one another guy I've had in my cabin for 3 years just took the plunge when he returned home. We also had 13 students sign up for UCC recruits weekend. God was working and I give him all the glory.

So what does this mean for you? If you are ages 7-18 make sure you spend a week at summer camp. Football camp may help with your spiral, but Bible camp will show you "The way" to be saved and prepare you for Christian life. If you are a parent or grandparent, get your teens to Camp Yamhill or Roundlake. Camp Yamhill Dates: July 7-8, 1st and 2nd grade camp: July 16-21, 3-4th, July 9-14, 5 and 6th. Roundlake Christian Camp July 30-August 5 (ages 11-18).
