Fun Facts About Our Clothing Give Away:

- We have been giving away clothes every August for 40 years!!!
- > The give away started as a clothing swap among mothers in the church, and grew to be a huge event that serves our community.
- For the last 5 years, we have helped clothe more than 1,000 individuals per event.
- We used to give away clothes, shoes, and coats for men, women and children every summer, but we have had to scale back and this year we are just providing items for kids ages 0-18.

August 20th-23rd: Come to the building any time to help put clothes on hangers and hang them on the racks.

Wednesday, August 23rd, 6pm: Come to the building to hang clothes with a group of people and fill our racks for the Give Away! Snacks provided.

August 24th-26th, 9am-4pm each day: Come down to the building for an hour or two during the give away to talk to shoppers and hang clothes. Breakfast and lunch provided for volunteers.

Wednesday August 30th, 6pm: Help us clean up the basement and get everything back in the sheds! Snacks provided.

Despite the Give Away being in August, this is a yearround Ministry that requires lots of work. We get donations almost every day, which need to be sorted, washed, and bagged so they are ready to be hung up when we need them. We get calls from the community, with people wanting to donate large amounts of clothing to our Ministry, and these donations need to be picked up and brought to the church. Sometimes people donate things we can't use, and we need to get those donations to organizations which can use them. 
