Most of them were teens I counseled in the late 90's/early 2000's. The keynote speaker was Aaron Partlow, one of my former campers who is now a youth minister in Texas. I got to talk with his dad (who counseled me) and watch him baptize his niece. I believe as a smaller church, it's crucial we get our teens to these area wide events. It gives them a chance to get to know God and other believers from other churches. At this retreat, the love of God crossed at least 3 generations and 3 states. It's a powerful thing.
