Since 2020, our holiday food "boxes" have been WinCo gift cards. This was a safer way to supply families with food during the COVID regulations. Additionally, by providing each family with the same amount of money on a gift card, we are preventing food waste by not giving food items that won't be used and catering to every individual's diet and preferences since everyone does their own shopping. WinCo also works with us to supply gift cards that can only be used to buy food, not alcohol or tobacco products.
