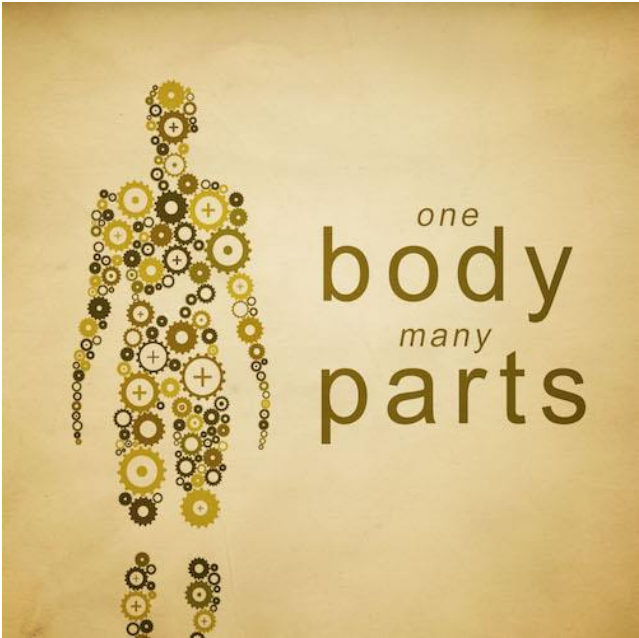

Thomas is still recovering from his LVAD surgery earlier this summer. This was a life-saving procedure for him that helps his heart continue to do its job, but Thomas is still in need of a heart transplant. He is doing everything he can to get placed on the transplant list, and once he is on that list, he could still wait up to two years.

One of the requirements for being on the heart transplant list is to live within 30 minutes of OHSU. The Puetts found a house in Portland back in June, and it is finally ready for them to move in! They will be moving from Springfield to Portland on Wednesday September 6th. They have a lot of people to help them load up on Wednesday afternoon, but **they need help unloading in Portland at 6pm.** Please contact Thomas or Amy if you can help.

To help offset the costs of moving and medical treatment, on Friday September 15th and Saturday September 16th, Circle Church of Christ will host a garage sale. All money collected will go to Thomas, Amy, Madison, Mitchell, Matthew, Moriah and Melissa Pruett. Please make sure to come and shop on those days!
