I just had a study with a student who went to Catholic school for 13 years. I asked him about his childhood, teenage years and his experience with Spiritual things. Then I asked him, "in your opinion, who is Jesus?" Then I sat back, zipped my lip and committed to not say anything until next time. He sat in thunderstruck silence for a few seconds. "Wow, I think I believe what the Bible says, but no one has ever asked me that question. Thank you, I'm going to have to think about this."

Life magazine wants to talk about this. Your friends and relatives want to talk about this (though they probably don't want to listen to us preach at them or argue with them; they want us to listen). We shouldn't assume the answer is yes just because we've seen people in a church building. Have you asked your best friends, your relatives, and your kids? How about yourself?
