CHRIST-MÁS GIFT X-CHANGE


You may have noticed a change to our foyer bulletin board! We were issued a challenge last week that looked like this:



"Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer (Romans 12:12)." Sometimes God answers prayer slowly. Since 2016 I've been praying for a statewide campus ministry movement in Churches of Christ. Howard Jones (Keizer Church of Christ) and I led our first statewide campus ministry retreat in 2016 and it was small, I think about 12 people. However, we kept praying about it and we saw gradual growth over time up to 26 people. However, this year, we've had a huge breakthrough. Now students are planning these activities on their own without our supervision. Southwest, Keizer, and Eugene all host college/young adult activities once a month, so now almost every weekend we have a statewide college/young adult event. We have always had this kind of statewide youth ministry (in Oregon, we do camps, youth rallies and TNT's together) so it's great to see this spread to young adults. I feel it has been a gradual grind, and now we've just had an explosion of young adult's ministry in Oregon. Praise God for all he is doing!
