New Year, New Habits!

How are you going to grow closer to God in 2024? Here are some ideas to get you inspired!

Take the K-LOVE Challenge. Listen to nothing but K-LOVE for all of January. You can sign up on their website if you want, or just listen.

Begin a Bible Reading plan. There are so many kinds to choose from. If you want to read the whole Bible in a year, you can choose a plan that will do that cover-tocover, in chronological order, or even where you read something from the Old Testament and the New Testament each day. You could also choose to begin a plan that will get you through just the Old or New Testaments, if the whole Bible in a year sounds a bit daunting. Don't like set plans? Perhaps you could set aside a time every day to read, and choose each day what you want to read. Or you could choose a plan that follows a theme throughout the Bible, such as love, peace, salvation, or many more. There is no right way to read your Bible, and no such thing as "failing" at a plan. If you miss a day, simply pick up where you left off when you can.

If you haven't already, memorize the Books of the Bible. There are songs to help you memorize, and this really will aid in your Bible studies as you will be able to find verses quickly and easily.

Consider asking someone to be your Prayer Partner. You can set aside time each week to meet together to pray in person or via phone call, or even text or email prayer requests, praises, and updates regularly.

Start a faith journal. You can write your prayers, notes from your Bible readings, take notes on sermons, write down favorite verses, journal about your faith, or anything that will help you grow in your faith this year.

Any time you spend in the Word will help you grow in your faith and deepen your relationship with God, so don't worry about being "perfect" in these habits. Just set some goals, try your best to stick with them, and let your faith grow!
