EEM: Eastern European Missions


Lanny Tucker, EEM Regional Director, will be here at Circle on Sunday April 7th. He will give our 9:30 Bible Class talk and he will give the sermon during our 10:30 Worship service.


EEM (Eastern European Missions) publishes, prints, and distributes Bibles and Bible based materials in more than 30 countries and more than 20 languages through a vast network of partner churches and organizations. They share God's Word with the people of Eastern Europe and beyond, and seek to educate and inspire God's servants in this work.

The mission of EEM began in 1961 when a small band of missionaries answered God's call to take his Word to people in the Soviet Union. They smuggled Bibles and printed materials underground until the wall fell in 1989, and today they freely supply Bible and Biblebased materials. The materials are given to individuals and families in youth camps, refugees, mission churches, public schools, universities and libraries, prisons, hospitals, orphanages, and anywhere else Bibles are needed.

During our 9:30am Bible Class on April 7th, Lanny will speak directly about EEM and the work they do, and he will give the sermon and tell some stories about Eastern Europe during our 10:30 Worship service.

Please make sure you are here on April 7th to meet Lanny and hear about the work of this Ministry.
