Motherhood In The Church Wes Hanson

As we approach **Mother's Day** as a congregation, I will choose to address "**motherhood**" from a **more expansive spiritual perspective**. Recognizing that for a variety of reasons not every woman will be a mother in the physical sense, the Scriptures nevertheless urge us to **honor all of our older women as if they were mothers (1 Tim 5:1-2)**. And rightly so when we recognize the labor of love they perform among us.

I am convinced that the women of the church are uniquely suited to express their God-given "motherhood" within the work and fellowship of the church in ways that are necessary and important for the proper functioning of the church. Our older women are charged with the motherly task of mentoring the subsequent generations of younger women (Titus 2:3-5). **Our view of motherhood should honor all of the wise, generous, diligent women among us** who, like Dorcas, or Apphia, or Priscilla, or Nympha, or Peter's mother-in-law, or Rufus' mother, step in with a motherly hand and a motherly heart to minister to the needs of others.

We should remember that Jesus himself referred to the church as "my mother and brothers" and he promised that those who had lost mothers would find them "a hundredfold" within the fellowship of God's people (Mk 3:34; 10:29-30). **Every member is meant to find the wholeness of family within the church-** the childless participates in nurturing the young and all are loved by many mothers. The church owes a debt of gratitude to all who serve these motherly roles among us. We should honor our women highly for their labor of love.
