### WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS ABOUT "GOOD WORKS."

Ephesians 2:10 says that, as Christians, we are "CREATED in Christ Jesus FOR GOOD WORKS." Titus 2:14 says that one of the purposes of God in redeeming us was to draw out from the general population of the world "a people for his own possession who are ZEALOUS FOR GOOD WORKS." It goes on in the following chapter to say that, as "God's people," we must remember to be "READY FOR EVERY GOOD WORK." we must be CAREFUL TO DEVOTE OURSELVES TO **GOOD WORKS,"** and we must "LEARN TO DEVOTE **OURSELVES TO GOOD WORKS"** (Titus 3:1,8,14). In Hebrews 10:24, we are informed that one of the purposes of the frequent assembly of the church is that we would "STIR UP ONE ANOTHER TO LOVE AND GOOD WORKS." Verse 25 goes on to say that we must "NOT NEGLECT TO MEET TOGETHER, AS IS THE HABIT OF SOME, BUT ENCOURAGE ONE ANOTHER, AND ALL THE MORE....'

One gets the rather distinct impression from the New Testament authors that God EXPECTS every Christian to be excitedly engaged in good works both individually and collectively! It is abundantly apparent that God wants our promotion of and engagement in GOOD WORKS to be frequent, habitual and intense! Good works should be done personally and collaboratively. We should do our part and support others in doing theirs. Doing good should become such a natural part of who we are as God's people that we almost come to view it as, "no big deal," while simultaneously acknowledging that we may very well be making a world of good difference by the simplest acts of casual kindness in a mean world. So smile. Be friendly and kind. Talk to strangers. Help your neighbors out. Lift others up. Volunteer with ministries of the church. Find a spot to serve and give yourself fully to collaboration with God's purposes.

As Christians we must intentionally fill our life with works of goodness. There is more to being a good Christian than simply quitting works of evil; we must be proactively engaged in good works. We must faithfully anticipate that God has prepared good works for us to do each day. We must seek out these opportunities to do good and train ourselves to recognize them when they appear. We must adjust our attitudes to be excited and steadfast in bringing God's goodness into the lives of others. Paul's quotation of Jesus in Acts 20:35 must ring true in every Christian heart, "we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'" After all, He Himself did not come to be served, but to serve.
