Is anyone else a big Olympics fan? I don't watch sports that often (though I enjoy playing most sports), but I do love watching the Olympics. I think part of the excitement is seeing team USA dominate. There is a feeling of pride when we see USA's best on the podium and hear the national anthem, isn't there? While I don't think it's sinful to support USA athletes, I do think it's a good time to think about our true citizenship,

"But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ, who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body" (Phil 3:20-21).

The reality is, we are NOT Americans, we are Christians.
