Prayer Calendar:

I just discovered a simple and useful prayer technique called a prayer calendar. First, write down the names of 5 friends. Then write the names of 5 relatives. Then write the names of 5 acquaintances, 5 neighbors, 5 co-workers/classmates, and 5 people from earlier in life (the acronym to remember for these categories is F.R.A.N.C.E.). This should give you 30 names. Then take a calendar, and write one person's name on each day of the month. Each day, either call that person, or send them a text asking how you can pray for them. Once you find out what they need, pray with them, or send a prayer text. I've found this is a great way to align yourself with God's mission, encourage believers, and witness to non-believers. Let's be a praying church!
