Thankful For You

I am thankful to God for each one of you, brothers and sisters. Your collaboration together is a blessing to God's Kingdom, our congregation and a tremendous encouragement to me personally.

For the month of November we will be focusing on aspects of Gratitude. The theme verse for this "miniseries" is Ephesians 5:20 which says, "Always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." This week we will focus on "The Secret of Being Content." The key text for the sermon will be Philippians 4:4-20.

One of the main points I will put forward in this first sermon is that **CONTENTMENT** is something Paul LEARNED. In fact he twice says "I have learned" in verses 11 and 12. Something we likely miss in reading an English translation is that he uses two subtly different words in the Greek language. The first word, "MANTHANO [G3129]," connotes the idea of knowledge gained through realization or experience. The second, "MUEO [G3453]," connotes the idea of knowledge gained through instruction or revelation.

What Paul had learned can be learned by us as well and in the same way Paul learned it- through a growing recognition of the truth of God's promised provision as we experience it in our lives. This means that the more we read the promises of God the better we recognize their fulfillment in our lives and the more we acknowledge the experience of God's constant care for us, the deeper our faith and trust become and the deeper our sense of contentment becomes.

And who do we have to thank for all these things? We direct our sincere gratitude Heavenward. Let us be "always giving thanks to God the Father for everything in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ" (Ephesians 5:20).
