Food Box Information

Circle Church of Christ gives food boxes to families in our church and community every Thanksgiving and Christmas. Thanksgiving food boxes will be distributed on **November 17th** and Christmas food boxes will be distributed on **December 15th**.

If you or someone you know can use a food box for Thanksgiving or Christmas, please let Maria Zhang or Charlene Franklund know. If you know of someone in the community who could benefit from a food box for Thanksgiving or Christmas, please have them call Maria at 541-758-4456. Priority for food boxes is given to church members, but we try to work with everyone who needs one.

Each food box costs \$130, and we give 20-25 food boxes at Thanksgiving and Christmas, for a total of 40-50 food boxes per year, costing \$5,200-\$6,500 annually. These food boxes go to families in the church and community who can't always make ends meet, and helping them with food frees up money for the family to use on Christmas gifts for children, property taxes, increased heating bills and other end-of-year expenses. If you would like to donate specifically to our food box fund, please write "Food Boxes" in the memo line of your checks, put cash in an envelope labelled "Food Boxes" or give online via Tithely by selecting the "Food Boxes" category. Thank you for supporting this important ministry!
