

Happy New Year! This year Wes has given us a challenge to read through the One Year Bible. I'd like to give a few practical tips. A) Set aside a time when you will read each day. For most people, the best time is in the morning before the day starts. I don't recommend before bed, you are tired, and stuff interrupts you. When you complete a day's reading, mark it in your Bible or on your phone. B) If you miss 1 day, you can make it up. If you miss 2 days, just restart on the current day. Each daily reading takes 15-30 minutes, so if you miss 3 days, it will take over 1 hour to catch up. This starts to get impossible. The daily goal of encountering God in his Word is more important 100% achievement. It's better to read 80% of the Bible than to get discouraged and give up. C) Have multiple Bible copies, so you always have your Bible when traveling. I have 1) a paper copy that I keep in the car, 2) a kindle copy on my phone and 3) the "One Year Bible Podcast" on my phone (this is free and can be found in the Apple podcasts app). If you need help with any of these digital options, give me a call 503-866-9117. 4) Live the word in community. Talk about what you read with your family. Also, UCC will do this as a Bible class this term. I encourage other life groups/classes to do this "Do not merely listen to the word and so deceive yourselves, Do what it says" (James 1:22).
