'Ready Defense' is a 10-week course that will be taught by **Wes Hanson** in association with Northwest School of Discipleship. It will meet weekly on Thursdays from 2:00-4:30pm at Hill Street Church of Christ in Albany beginning on September 11th. This course is intended to introduce practical definitions, purposes, and methodologies for effective Christian apologetics and develop the skills for articulating well-reasoned responses to some common arguments and objections laid against Christianity. From Gregory Koukl's book, Tactics, we will learn a practical methodology for crafting conversations that encourages others to consider the reasonableness of belief in Christianity while gently pointing out the flaws in other systems of thought. Some class time will be spent in conversational role-playing to practice these skills. Importantly, as ambassadors for Christ, this course will emphasize the appropriate attitude, tone, and demeanor of one making a defense for hope in Jesus- gentleness and respect.
