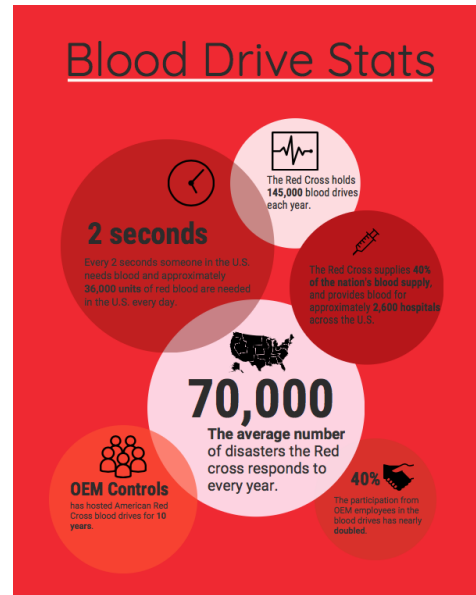

### Connect With Your Kids: Ideas For Easter



(Below) Cut a donut in half and place it on the cut side to symbolize Jesus' tomb. Put a donut hole next to it to symbolize the stone that was rolled away.

(Above) Dip a marshmallow in melted butter and roll it in cinnamon and sugar. Cover the marshmallow with biscuit dough and bake. The marshmallow will disappear! This symbolizes how Jesus' body was prepared with oil and spices, placed in the tomb, and rose, leaving an empty tomb.
